Intermunicipal agreements

City of Bandung

As part of our collaboration with the City of Bandung, we have deepened discussions on future cooperation projects between our two cities. This work should form the basis for the renewal of an MoU (Memorandum of Understanding). We have also held discussions with AWEX in this context.



City of Cluj-Napoca

As part of our participation in the Culture Next Conference, organized last October in Cluj-Napoca in the context of Namur's bid to become European Capital of Culture 2030, we also had

City of Bourg-en-Bresse

This mission, centered around a Masterclass organized in Bourg-en-Bresse, was marked by enriching pedagogical exchanges and contributed to strengthening the links between our two towns.

Hué City

In March, we welcomed a delegation led by the Chairman of the Hué City People's Council, who is also Municipal Secretary of the Hué Party. The visit followed the 2022 trip by the Mayor and Chairman of the Hué People's Committee. The exchanges enabled us to strengthen our collaboration and to continue discussions on the City of Hué's project, which aims to draw inspiration from the Namur, Intelligent and Sustainable (NID) concept, in order to adapt it to their context in Vietnam. In this context, Namur offered its expertise to the City of Hué by producing a project outline entitled HID (Hué Intelligent and Sustainable), to support this approach. At the AIMF Board meeting in Paris in October, we invited the City of Hué to ensure that the HID project was tailored to local realities.







During the AIMF Congress in Lausanne, the cities of Namur and Hué renewed their commitment last May by signing the Protocol of Collaboration for the period 2024-2029. The signing of this Protocol, by Deputy Mayor Maxime Prévot and the Mayor - Chairman of the People's Committee of Hué, was one of the highlights of the AIMF Lausanne 2024 Congress. Three priority areas of cooperation were identified for the coming years: the digital transition, culture and heritage, and the development of green spaces. The first partnership agreement between the two cities was signed in 2010, also in Lausanne, during the 30th AIMF General Assembly..

This first artistic exchange between Namur en Mai and Réverbère represents a significant step in the collaboration between the two events. The next step is to welcome a Quebec delegation to the 2025 edition of Namur en Mai.

A co-creation residency between Ampli de Québec and Le Delta





Quebec City and Namur are both members of UNESCO's Creative Cities Network.
Quebec City is famous for its identity as a "City of Literature", while Namur stands out for its dynamism and innovation in the field of digital arts. In this context, an artistic residency in electronic music was held in Namur in October 2024, on the occasion of the KIKK



Festival. Organized by L'Ampli de Québec, in partnership with Le Delta, this initiative brought together Loup Fre\$h, beatmaker and DJ from Quebec, and Aemone, DJ and producer from Namur. The residency enabled the artists to explore new sounds, co-create and share their visions in an ideal setting for experimentation. Their collaboration culminated in a performance at the KIKK Festival, where the public could discover the results of their work. In 2025, this creative exchange will continue in Quebec City, where Aemone will be welcomed to continue this artistic dynamic and strengthen the cultural ties between the two twin cities.

to-city cooperation to foster dialogue and international solidarity, and to work together to tackle major global challenges by taking action as close as possible to the citizen.






AIMF office in Paris

role in welcoming a delegation from the Commune of Adrano, Sicily. Led by its Mayor, Mr. Fabio Mancuso, and accompanied by the President and members of the Municipal Council, the visit was initiated by the local Adranite community, the Adranam association. The official events took place at the Halle al'Chair and Place Maurice Servais, where the first families from Adrano, who came to settle in Namur as early as 1946, were honored. One of the most moving moments of the visit was the inauguration of a commemorative plaque, made of lava stone from Etna, a powerful symbol of the roots and ties that unite our two communities. The remainder of the stay was also punctuated by various highlights, encouraging cultural exchanges and strengthening the historical links between Adrano and Namur.







City of Terrebonne

Exchanges with the city of Terrebonne continued. A mission from Terrebonne to Namur is planned for 2025, as part of the cooperation agreement signed in November 2023. MUNICIPAL INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION



Namur is continuing its international municipal cooperation (CIC) with the Congolese Commune of Masina as part of a Belgian development cooperation program focusing on civil registry and population services. This program is managed by the Union des Villes et Communes de Wallonie (UVCW).

This year, the partnership reached a significant milestone with the replacement of Masina's last «container» office with the construction of a district office in Boba. A mission was carried out in June to mark the completion of work on this office and assess the infrastructure to be rehabilitated as part of the partnership.

Following this mission, a four-lot contract was launched. It covers the refurbishment of the Congo district office, the renovation of the Kasaï district office, the refurbishment of the Mandiangu and Pelende district offices, as well as the paving of the floors of the Masina civil registry, population and archive offices. Work is scheduled to start in early 2025.

Collaboration with the NGO PASCO

As part of its program to co-finance partnership projects for sustainable development, Wallonie-Bruxelles International has awarded a major grant to the City of Namur for a project with the NGO Parlons Sida Aux Communautaires (PASCO) in Masina, Democratic Republic of Congo, for the years 2024 and 2025.
